

**Altara Elementary School Teacher Heather Sullivan
Wins Golden Apple Award

Ms. Sullivan has taught 2nd grade at Altara Elementary for 14 years. She takes her responsibility as an educator very seriously and believes she can play an important role in helping assure that the needs of each one of her students are met. Ms. Sullivan notices everything in her classroom, from the little things, like a student who needs a backpack, to some of the bigger things, like a family that may not have enough food, and works with the community to help meet those needs. “Being a teacher is so much more than just teaching content,” she says, “you have to be a second mother to these kids.” She has approached several businesses in an effort to secure donations of winter clothing for students who do not have sufficient warm clothing to play at recess, like a student of hers that wears only a sweatshirt to and from school each day.

Ms. Heather Sullivan typically spends on average \$300-400 out of pocket for her students each year. In the past she has bought 10 pairs of pants, costumes for children whose parents may not be able to afford them, and countless treats and cleaning supplies to wipe down messy fingers. She plans on using the award money on a winter coat for a boy in her class that doesn’t have one and also a knit hat and gloves for him as well. She also plans on buying a backpack for a child who brings her work to school in a plastic sack, and if there is any money left over, she will buy school supplies for students to use at home to complete assignments which sometimes require students to color, cut and paste.
